

DUNURE KAYAKING

The Community Council has 8 "sit-on-top" Kayaks.

These are available for use by local residents.

But this is not a Club. We are not responsible for your training, your supervision on the water, or your safety. You use the Kayaks entirely at your own risk, and you are responsible for your own actions and inactions.

THE RULES:

1	Kayaks can only be used by persons age 10+.		
2	All persons using Kayaks must be competent swimmers.		
3	Each person under 16 must be accompanied in the water by an adult.		
4	Kayaks are for use in flat-calm, shallow water, not more than 20-30m offshore.		
5	All persons using Kayaks must have a basic understanding of their operation.		
6	Minimum 2 x Kayaks in the water at all times (and preferably 3).		
7	The condition of the Kayaks must be checked before use.		
8	Take care of the Kayaks. Do not damage them. Do not lose any equipment.		
9	Suitable clothing must be worn at all times (this means a Wetsuit or similar).		
10	Safety equipment must be worn at all times (this means a PFD and a Helmet).		
11	A basic survival kit must be taken each time (this means a mobile phone etc.).		
12	£5 charge for each Kayak. Under 16's free. All funds raised are reinvested.		
13	3 hours maximum duration - from pick-up to drop-off.		
14	No Kayaks will be issued within 2 hours of sunset.		
15	Launch Areas are restricted to either the Shore (Big Rock) or the Slip.		
16	Transportation to and from the water is your responsibility.	~	
17	Be aware of other water users (particularly Boats and Jet Skis).	~	
18	Call Alex Gibson, Steve Izatt or Janey McCreath if you want to use a Kayak.		
19	Certain children will have priority at all times because they helped with the funding applications, attended the funding events, and delivered presentations. Without their efforts, we would not have any Kayaks.	V	
20	Any person not complying with these Rules shall not be permitted further use.	V
