### **3. POLICE REPORT:**

Figures for Dunure area from 21/11/2012 to 19/02/2013 were as follows:  
22 incidents responded to by police, of these four crimes were recorded. Theft from  
Craig Tara; Vandalism – Dunure; Theft HB – Dunure (Garden shed); Theft HB – Fisherton  
Primary School which took place on a Friday evening and computers and laptops stolen.  
Mr Findlay concerned about content of hard drives getting into wrong hands and (Councillor  
Grant will look into this).  
Other issues of which to be aware and are of concern are rural crimes which include the theft  
of quad bikes and central heating oil.

### **4. COUNCILLORS' REPORT:**

Councillor Grant confirmed that he had attended a Fisherton Parent Council Meeting recently.  
He also advises that we should be prepared for a cut in all services, and suggests we contact and  
invite to our meetings various people to give us an insight as to the Council's priorities on road  
repairs and other matters.  
Welfare reform will cause lots of unpleasant issues and also that as a sign of the times there is  
now a food bank in Maybole.

## **5. MATTERS ARISING:**

- Carrick Place road repairs have still not been carried out. Councillor Grant will look into this.
- Handrail at shop – As the closure of the shop is imminent we will try and look into possibilities of funding is available to go forward with a Community Shop which would perhaps have one paid staff member and volunteers. Andy Guthrie will investigate this and have a chat with Julia Whitaker of Ailsa Horizons for guidance.
- Station Road – bushes on left proceeding towards village outside 30mph signs needing to be cut back. Not been attended to.
- Left verge and road surface on left on A719 between roundabout at Earls Way and Roundabout at Brown Carrick Drive in poor state of repair. Nothing done.
- Community Council Elections – forms have been completed. Mr Montgomerie advised us he will not be applying for re-election as feels he has been a Community Council member for a long time and it is time to hand over to other local residents.
