Minutes The minutes of the previous meeting on the 11th March 1986 were taken as read and adopted on a proposal from Mr Crawford seconded by Mr Storie.

Mr JKR Melrose becomes Vice-Chairman and welcomed Mr R Bunn to the Council.

Matters arising from Minutes

- 1. Treasurer's Report The balance stands at \$44.09 after a deduction of £80 to the Secretary.
- 2. Railway bridge Parapets A letter was received from the Divisional Engineer SRC saying he would look into this matter.
- 3. Smell nuisance at Fisherton Dunure A report was received from the Divisional Manager, Department of Sewage SRC regarding the complaint of a possible septic tank effluent discharge into the small stream which runs between the edge of the field and the road. As this report is comprehensive it was agreed that each Council member should receive a copy for discussion at the next meeting. The Council also agreed to send a copy to the Divisional Engineer SRC.
- 4. Dumping of rubbish in vicinity of Dunure The Council agreed to telephone the Director of the Environment about this matter.
- 5. Erection of sign at T-junction Dunure Mains In a letter to the Council the Divisional Engineer said that he would look into this matter.
- 6. Carrick Community Transport Group The Chairman informed the Council that the community 'bus was being fully utilised.

Any other business

The Council agreed to donate £50 to Fisherton Church.

It was brought to the attention of the Council that

- 1. the double yellow lines at the Post Office corner have not been repainted. The Council agreed to telephone the Divisional Engineer SRC about this matter.
